Exception Alert!

Sound: **“I”**
as in **PIE**
OR **“AI”**



When you have a Patach vowel followed by the letter Yud at the end of a word, altogether it makes the sound I (as in PIE).

Sound:
Shee-Rie



Or:
Shee-Rai

Sound:
Dih-Va-Rie



Or:
Dih-Vah-Rai

A Patach followed by a י at the end of a word sounds like I as in pie.

Exception Alert!

Sound: **“I”**
as in PIE



When you have a Kamatz vowel followed by the letter Yud at the end of a word, altogether it makes the sound I (as in PIE).

Sound: **“Ey”**
as in HEY



When you have a Segol vowel followed by the letter Yud at the end of a word, altogether it makes the sound EY (as in HEY).

Sound: **“Ey”**
as in HEY



When you have a Tzeirei vowel followed by the letter Yud at the end of a word, altogether it makes the sound EY (as in HEY).
